

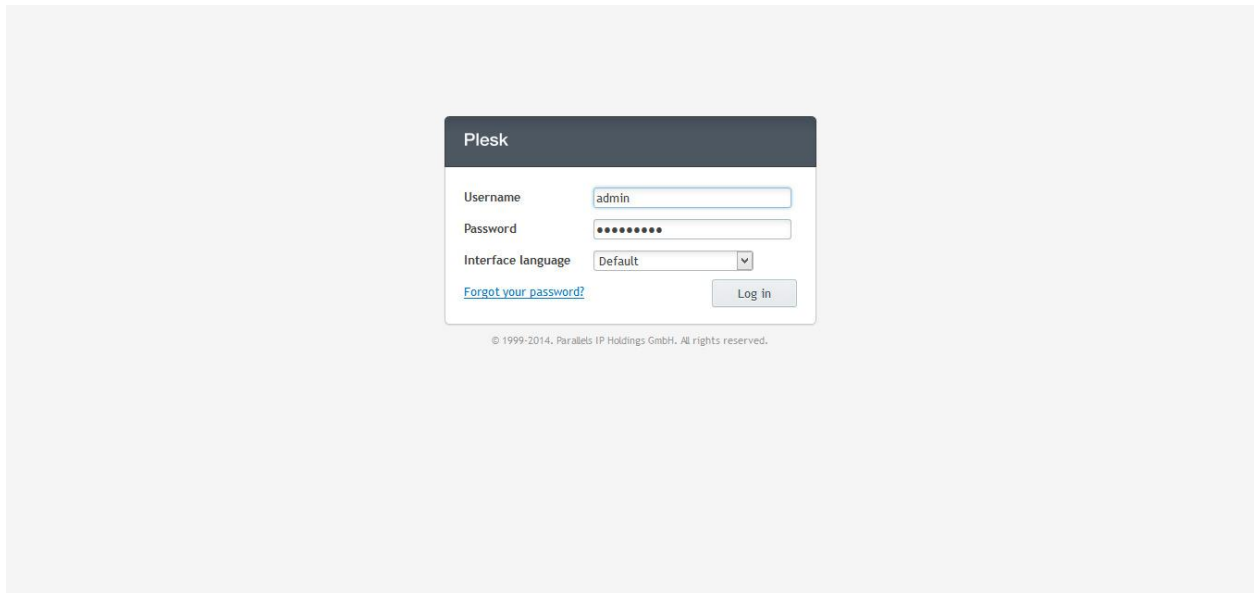

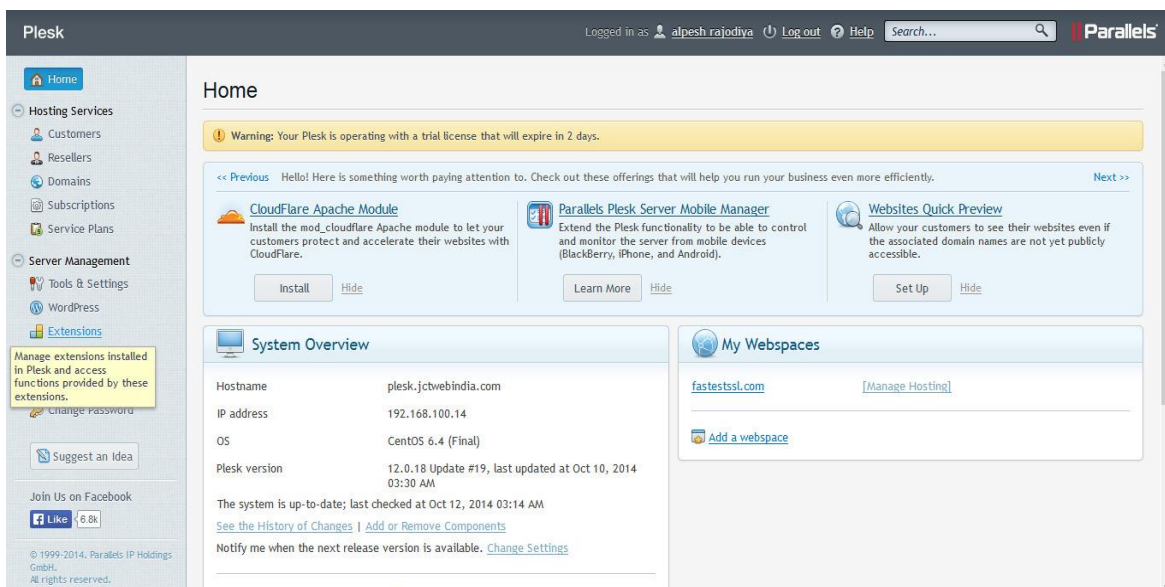
# Plesk Installation Guide

# AutoInstall SSL™ 2.0 Installation for Plesk

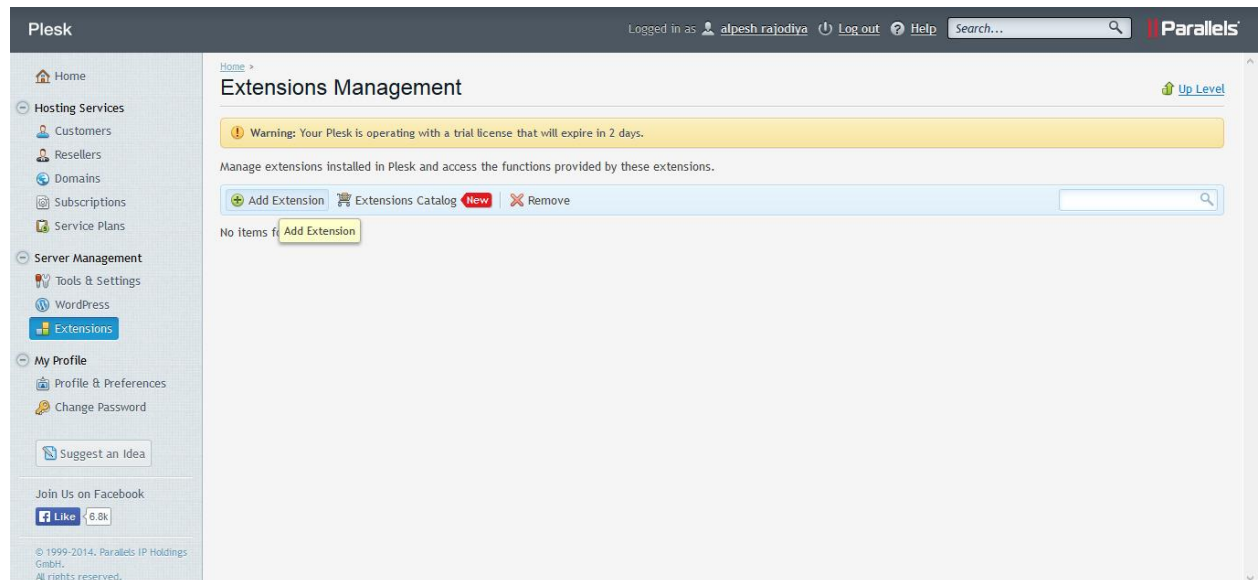
1. Download the plugin from <https://www.thesslstore.com/partner/plugins/autoinstall-plugin.aspx>
2. Login to your Plesk Panel



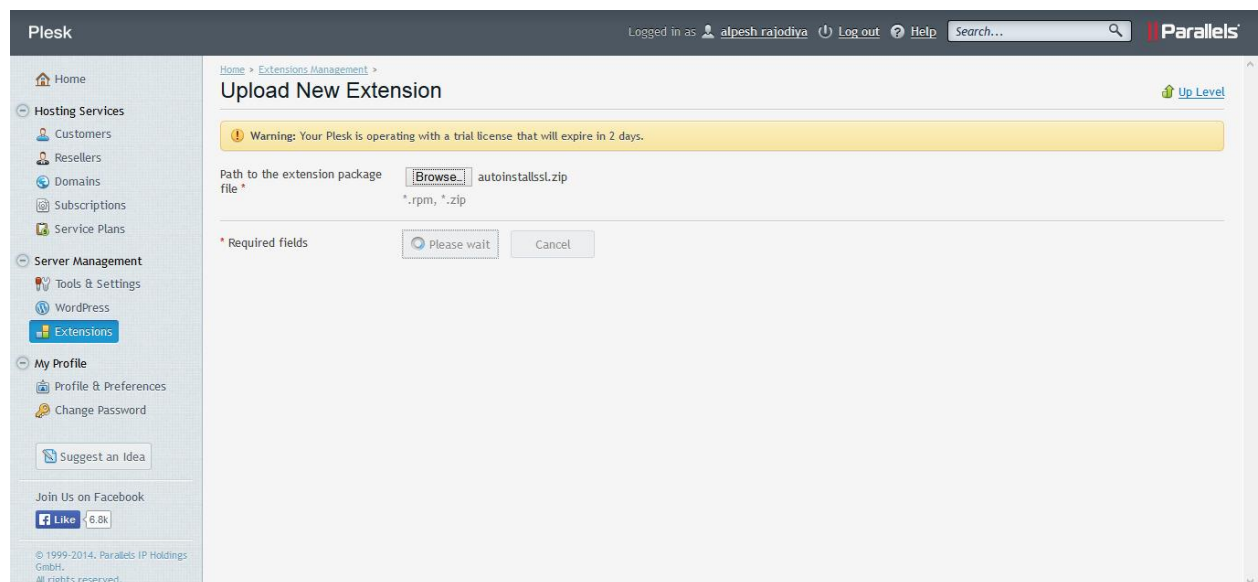
3. Click on Extensions under Server Management on the left hand panel.



#### 4. Click on Add Extension



#### 5. Browse the AutoInstall SSL .zip file and click on OK.
