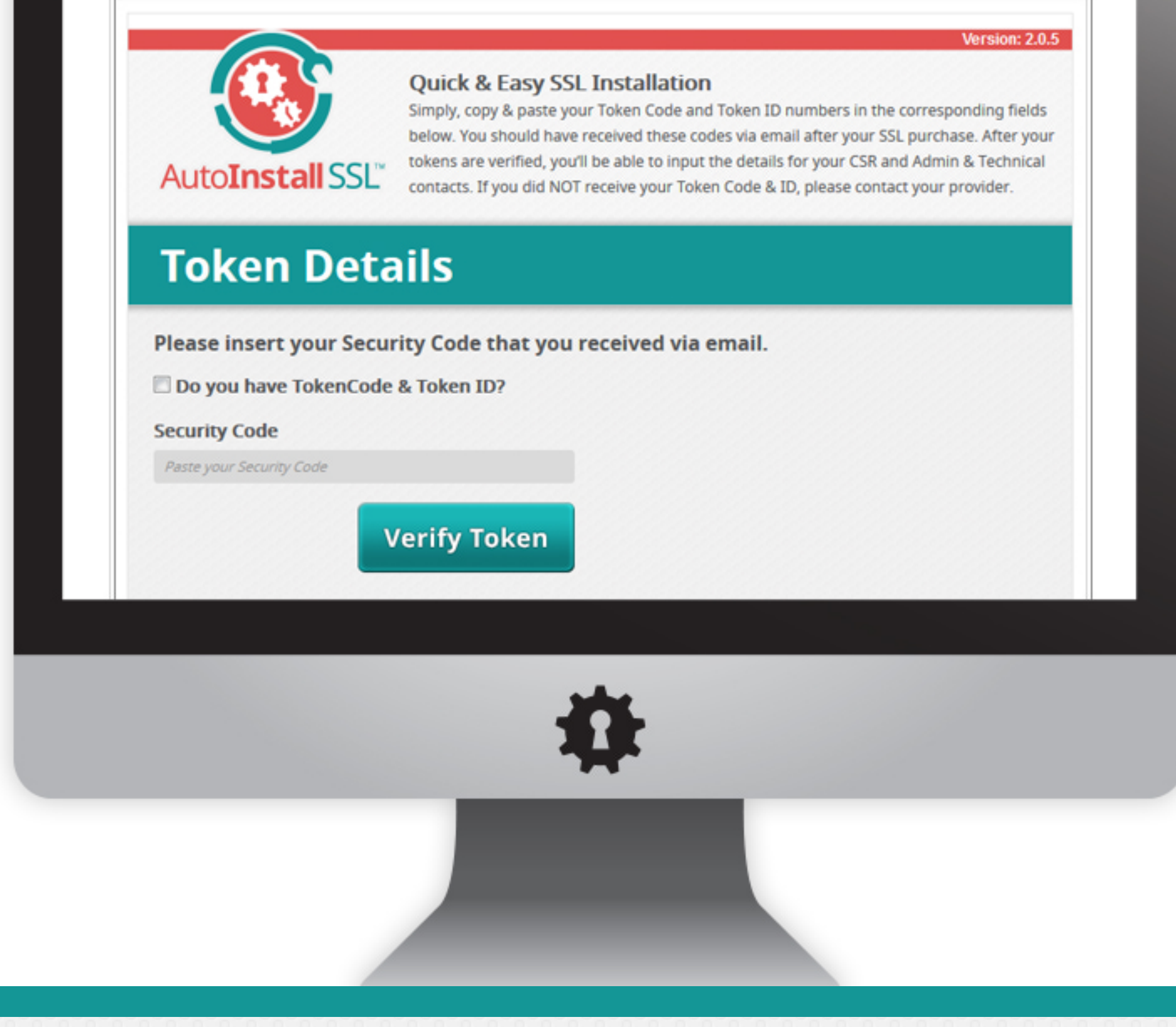


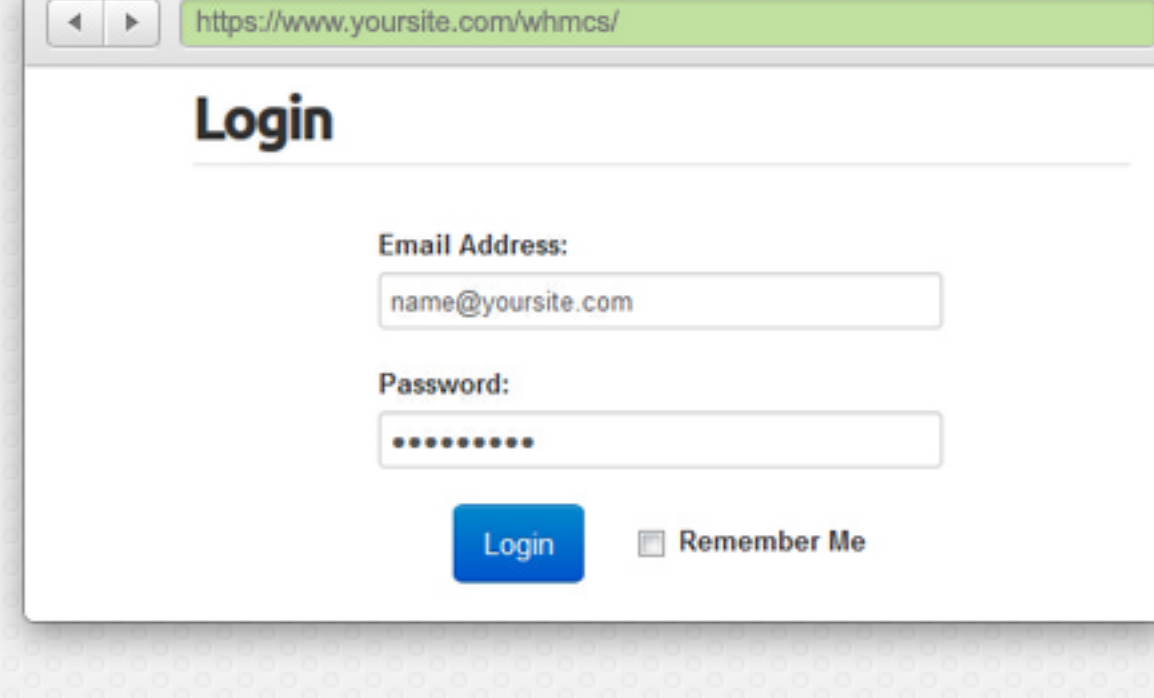
User Guide: Using AutoInstall SSL™ with WHMCS



These screenshots will take you through the entire SSL purchasing process using AutoInstall SSL™ in conjunction with our WHMCS plugin.

1 Login to WHMCS

- Simply login to your WHMCS panel.

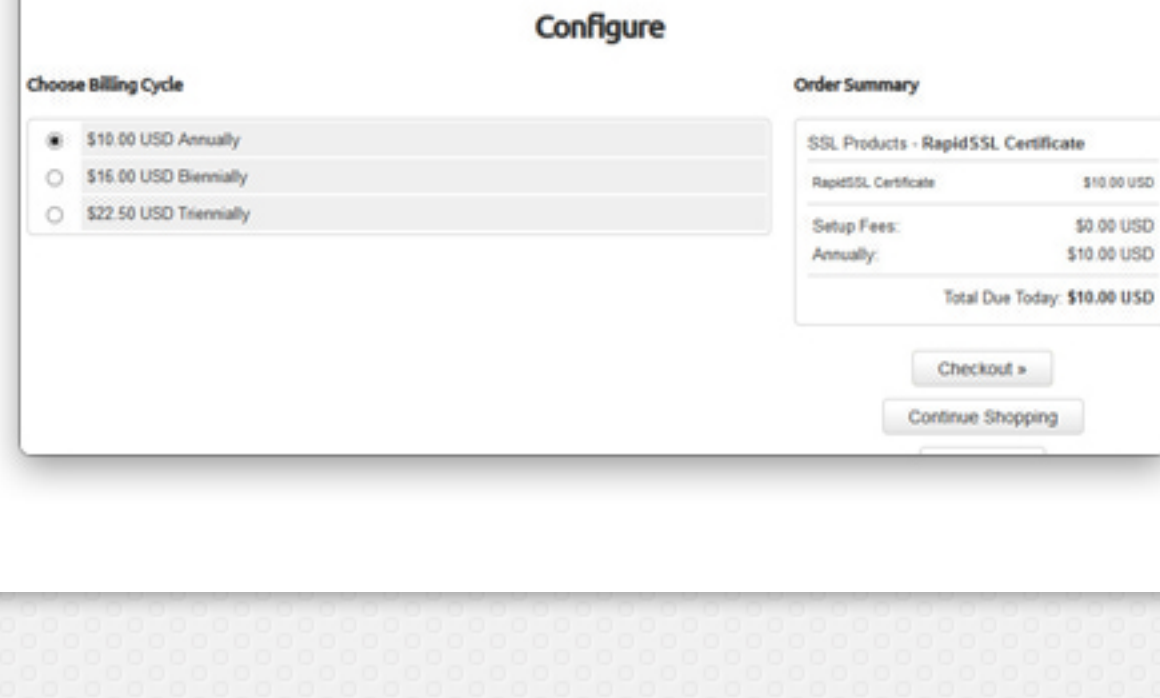
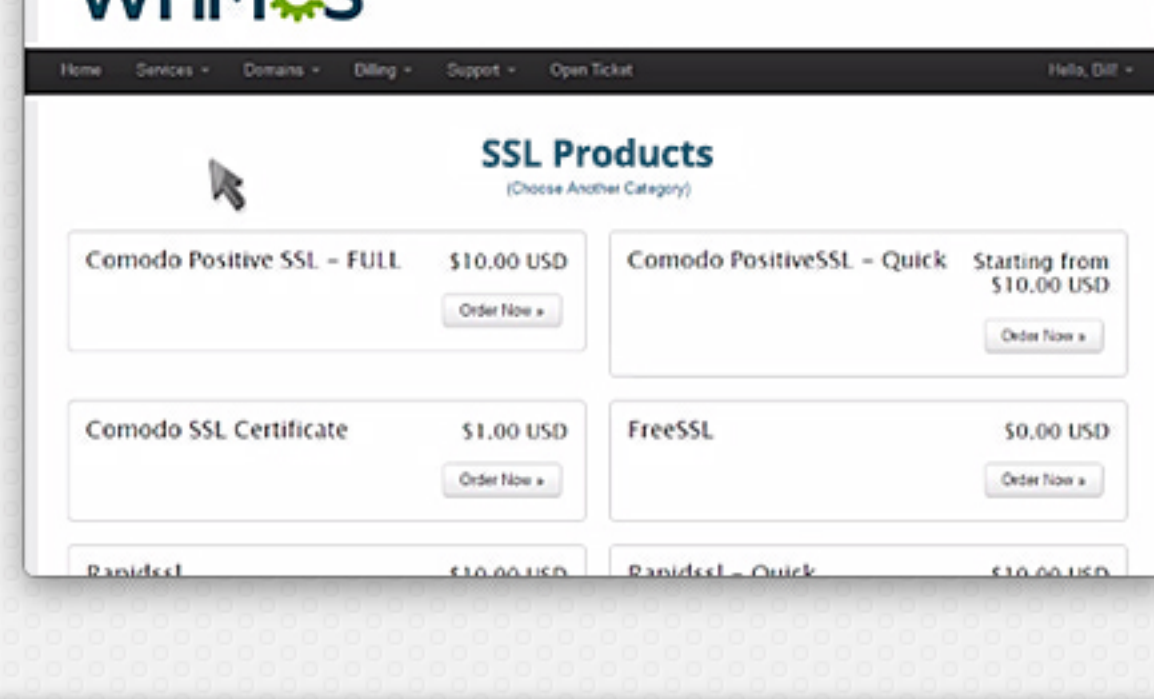
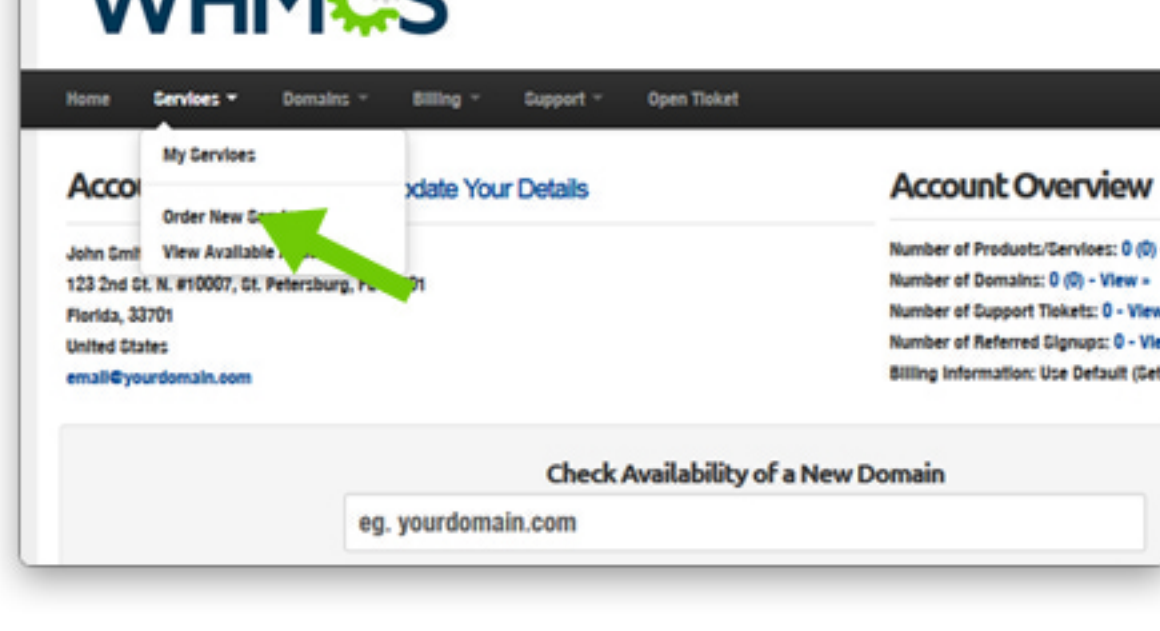


3 Select your SSL Certificate

- Here you will see the available SSL certificates for purchase, select the one you need.
- In this case, we have selected the Comodo Positive SSL.
- Click on "Order Now".

2 Order New Services

- Hover your mouse over the Services tab on the top left of the screen.
- Click on "Order New Services".

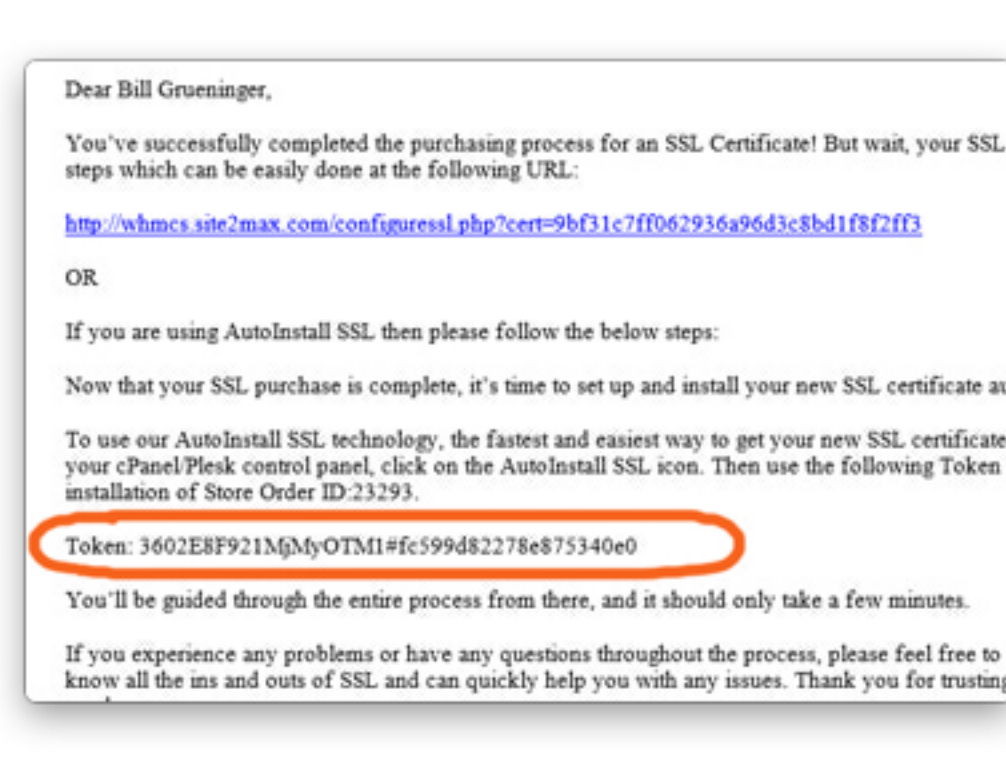
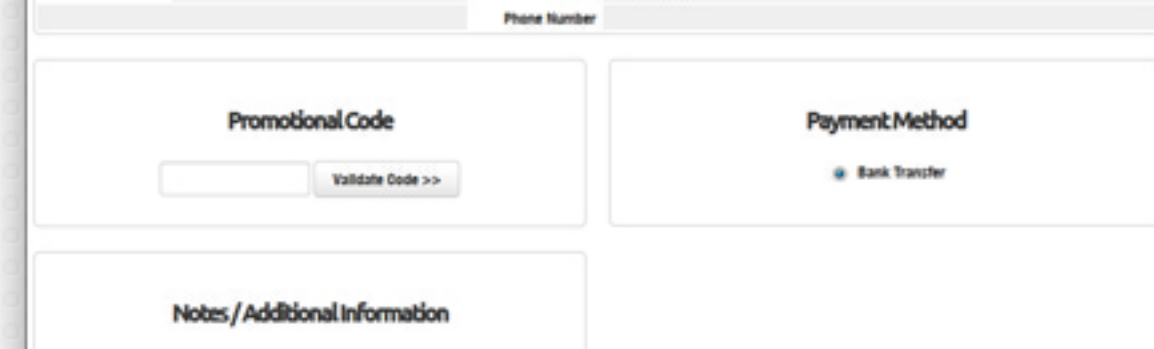


4 Review your Order

- Select the billing cycle you would like the certificate to be active for, in this case, we have selected Annually.
- Double-check all of your order details, then click "Checkout".

5 Complete your Order

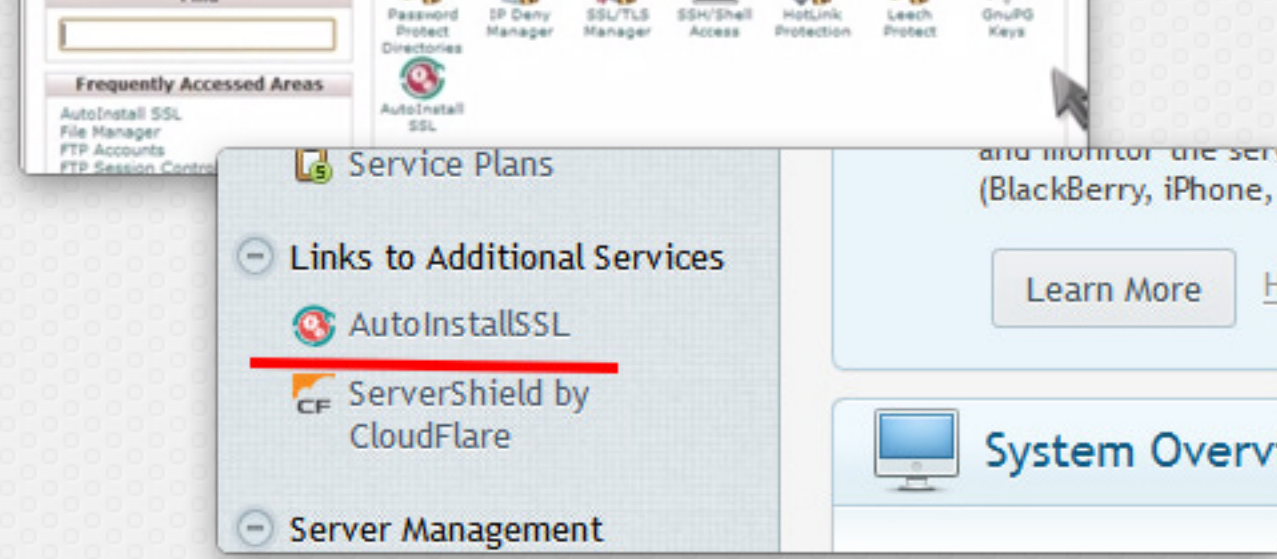
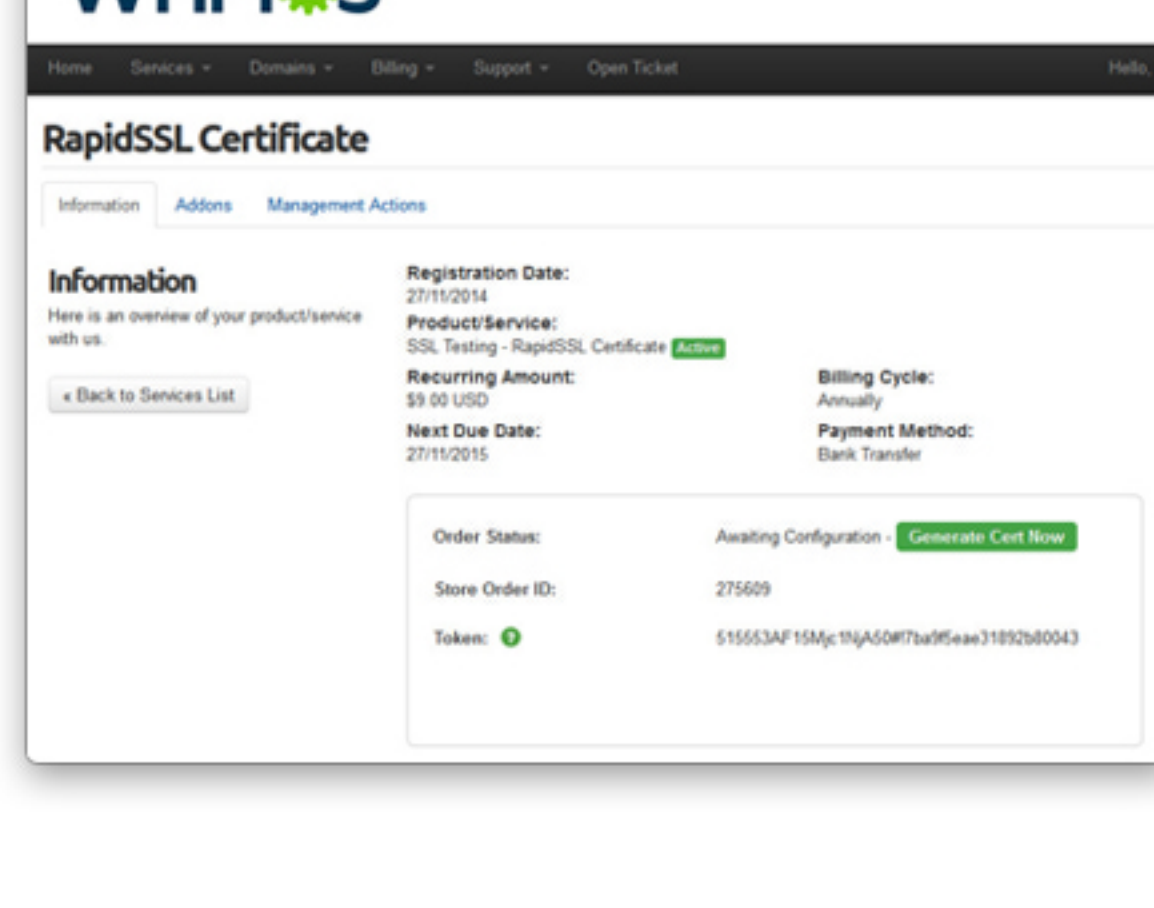
- Confirm that all of your customer details are correct on this page.
- Then click on "Complete Order" at the bottom of the screen.



6 Retrieve your Token

- The Token is unique identifying number that come with your certificate.
- This number is used during the AutoInstall SSL™ process to identify the specific certificate you need to install.
- After you purchase your certificate through WHMCS, you will be sent an automated email, which will have the Token inside.

- You can also find your Token inside of your WHMCS portal.
- Simply go back to the "Services" tab and click on "My Orders".
- Then, locate the certificate you are looking for and click on the "View Details" button on the right of the screen.
- The Token will be listed at the bottom of the page.

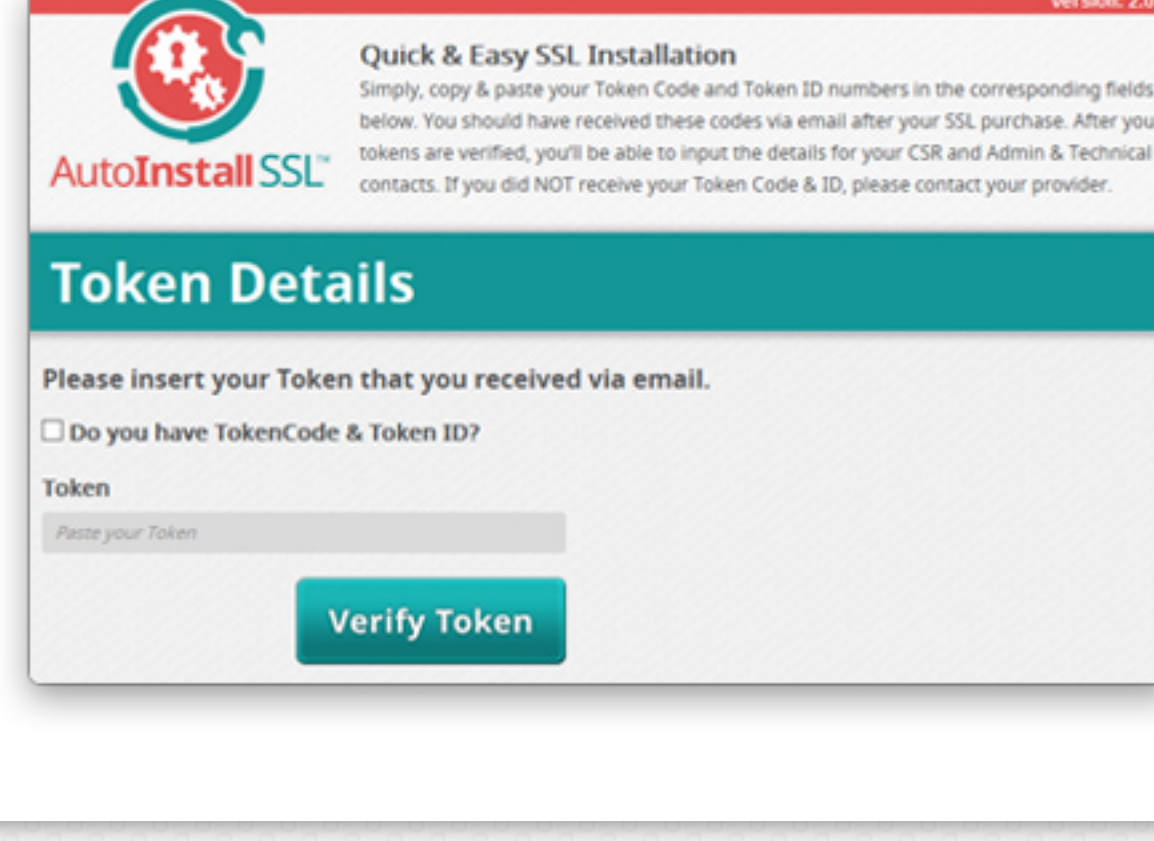


7 Complete your Order

- Now that you have the Token handy, login to your cPanel (or Plesk).
- Click on the AutoInstall SSL™ icon.

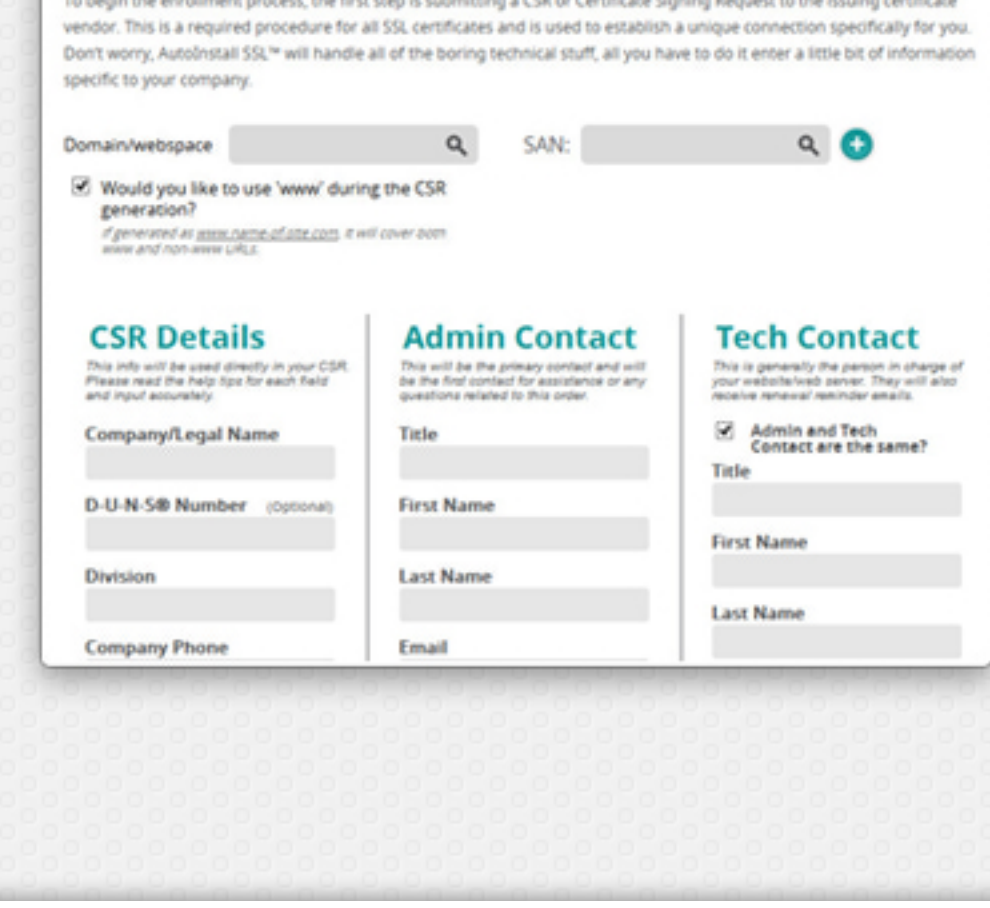
8 Verify your Tokens

- Enter your Token on the next page.
- Then, select the webspace for the SSL certificate and click "Verify Token."



9 Activate & Install your SSL Certificate

- On the next screen, enter your CSR Details, and Admin and Technical contact information.
- There is a box to check if the Admin and Technical contact information is the same.
- Next, click on "Activate & Install SSL Certificate".



10 Watch the Magic Unfold

- This will start the AUTOMATIC installation process of your SSL certificate. You will be given real-time updates once each step is complete, and if an error should occur, the process will be paused and you'll be directed to the issue.
- Once the certificate has been installed, you will be able to view it live on your site.
- That's it! You now have an active SSL certificate on your website without all of the hassles and aggravation of typical SSL installation ☺
